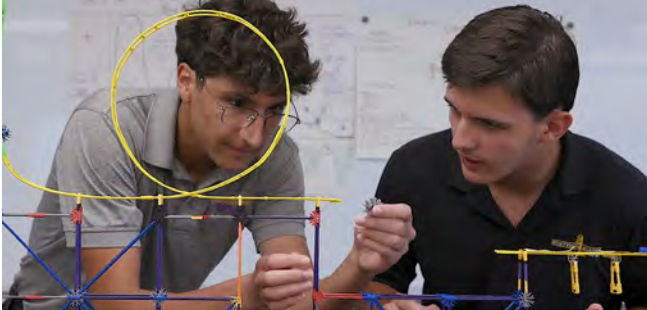

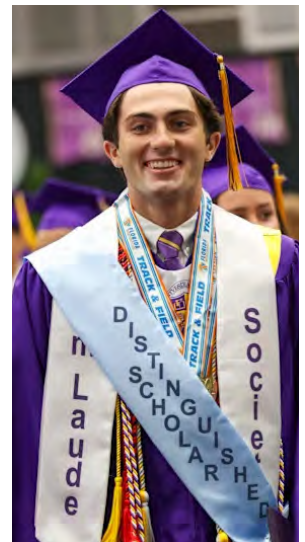

Campus Facilities

Montverde Academy's campus spans approximately 130 acres in Central Florida, providing spaces for academics, athletics, and the arts. Classrooms and labs support a range of subjects, including science and technology, while dedicated arts facilities host music, theatre, and visual arts programs. Athletic fields and indoor gymnasiums facilitate competitive training year-round. Residential Life

Boarding at Montverde Academy offers supervised residential living where students share rooms and engage in structured study hours and extracurricular activities. 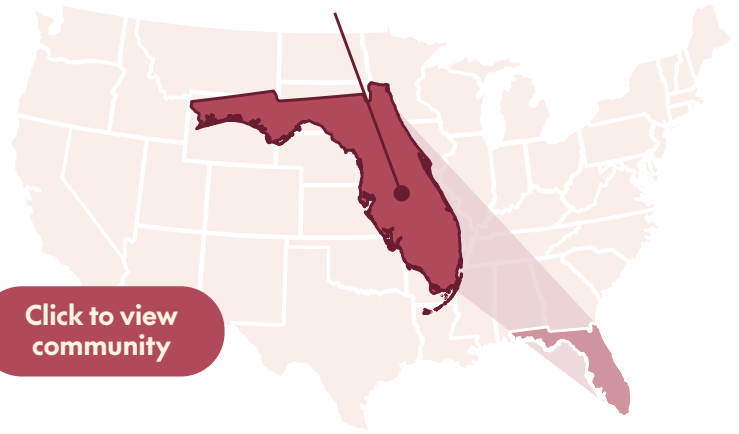
