Academic Excellence

North Broward Preparatory School (NBPS) delivers a college-preparatory curriculum incorporating honours, AP and International Baccalaureate diploma courses, plus dual-enrolment options. The Nord Anglia global network supplements classroom learning with partnerships that introduce advanced STEAM projects and professional arts instruction. Faculty include experienced teachers, many with advanced degrees, who provide personalised academic guidance and college counselling. NBPS supports English learners with structured ESL and TOEFL preparation. Graduates proceed to universities worldwide, aided by rigorous coursework, research opportunities, and portfolio development in the arts.


Student Accomplishments

Students achieve high academic outcomes and competitive arts and athletic recognition. The Class of 2024 posted an average IB score of 31, a 100% IB diploma pass rate, and notable SAT/ACT performance among the top percentiles. Arts students participate in national competitions and major productions through the Arts Academy; STEM students compete in robotics and MIT-linked challenges. Boarding students regularly engage in leadership, social service and international cultural programmes.

Campus Facilities

The expansive campus of about 80 acres houses STEAM maker spaces, innovation and computer labs, science facilities, performing and visual arts studios, and a dedicated Learning Commons. Athletic infrastructure includes gyms, an aquatic centre with three pools, tennis courts, a lighted stadium and a fitness/wellness centre. Residential students are accommodated in a modern International Village with medical services, study lounges, kitchenettes and communal areas. Landscaped grounds support outdoor learning and recreational activities.

Residential Life

The International Village hosts nearly 300 boarding students from 50+ nationalities in shared and single rooms with supervised study times, major weekend activities and residential programming. Facilities include lounges, study rooms, laundry, kitchenettes and on-site security. Residential staff coordinate orientation, cultural integration and academic support; a buddy system and structured routines promote well-being and cross-cultural exchange.

Athletics and Arts

Athletics are integral, with nearly 60 teams across 25 sports and competitive participation at district and state levels. The programme emphasises physical development, teamwork and college eligibility for student-athletes.

The Arts Academy delivers more than 70 fine and performing arts courses and structured pathways for students aiming for arts careers. The school partners with Juilliard for enhanced music and performing arts training and stages regular productions, exhibitions and portfolio development opportunities.


