The King's Academy offers a rigorous college preparatory program with Advanced Placement courses spanning sciences, mathematics, languages, social sciences, and the arts, enabling students to undertake college-level work while in high school. Dual enrollment partnerships with Palm Beach Atlantic University and Southeastern University allow qualified students to earn college credits on campus. Small class sizes and personalized academic support contribute to a 12:1 student-teacher ratio, supporting student mastery and readiness for postsecondary study. The school recently earned the National Blue Ribbon School designation, reflecting overall academic performance and student achievement.

Campus Facilities

The King's Academy's campus in West Palm Beach comprises academic buildings, science labs, and technology centers including the Boswell Science & Technology Center for STEM learning. Performing arts are supported by a 23,000 sq ft Center for the Performing Arts, with studios for theater, music, dance, and digital media. Athletic facilities include an 11,000 sq ft athletic complex, Olympic-sized pool, tennis academy, gymnasiums, fields for team sports, and weight training spaces. Outdoor areas and wellness spaces support recreation and interscholastic competition.

Residential Life

Boarding students live in supervised residence halls with structured daily schedules that balance academics, activities, and personal time. Residential staff provide academic check-ins, evening study hours, and weekend programming. Students have access to dining services, common lounges, and on-campus facilities throughout the week. The boarding community includes both domestic and international students, supporting cultural exchange and peer support within a safe and well-organized residential environment.

Athletics and Arts

The King's Academy fields a broad athletics program with varsity teams in football, basketball, baseball, lacrosse, soccer, tennis, cross country, golf, swimming, volleyball, track & field, cheerleading, and more.

Arts education includes performing arts, jazz ensemble, band, choir, theater productions, dance, and digital/media arts with nationally recognized ensemble performances.

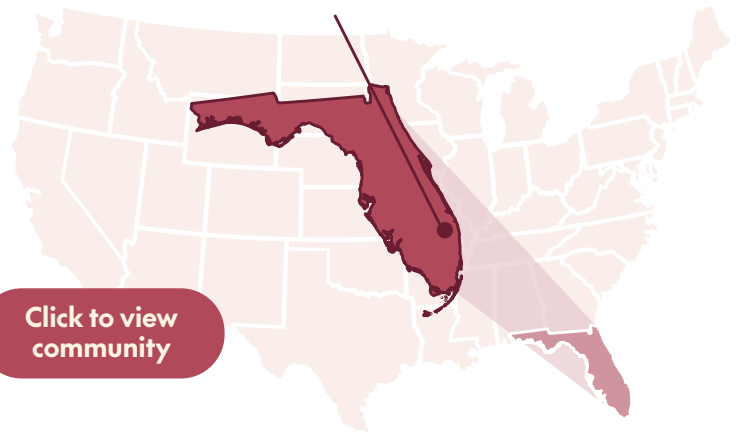
