Many of Washington Academy's competitive sports teams, including soccer, cheering, and basketball, have won state championships. The school's tennis team is extremely popular among the student body.

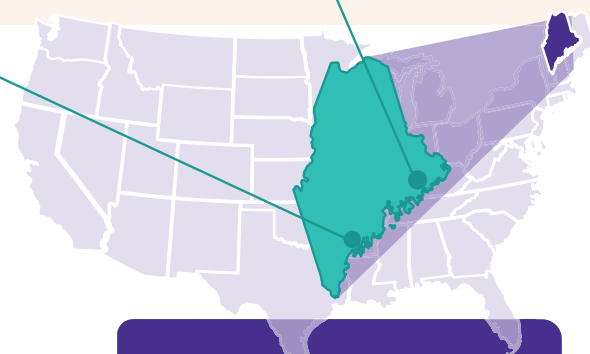
The school's arts department produces a play every school year and an annual Spring Show. Students also have the opportunity to learn to play the guitar or study cultural dance.
