SPORTS AND ARTS

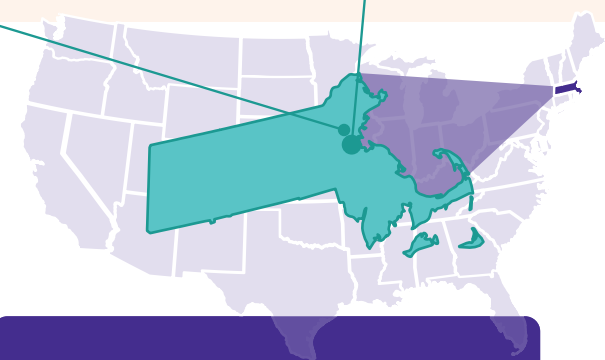
