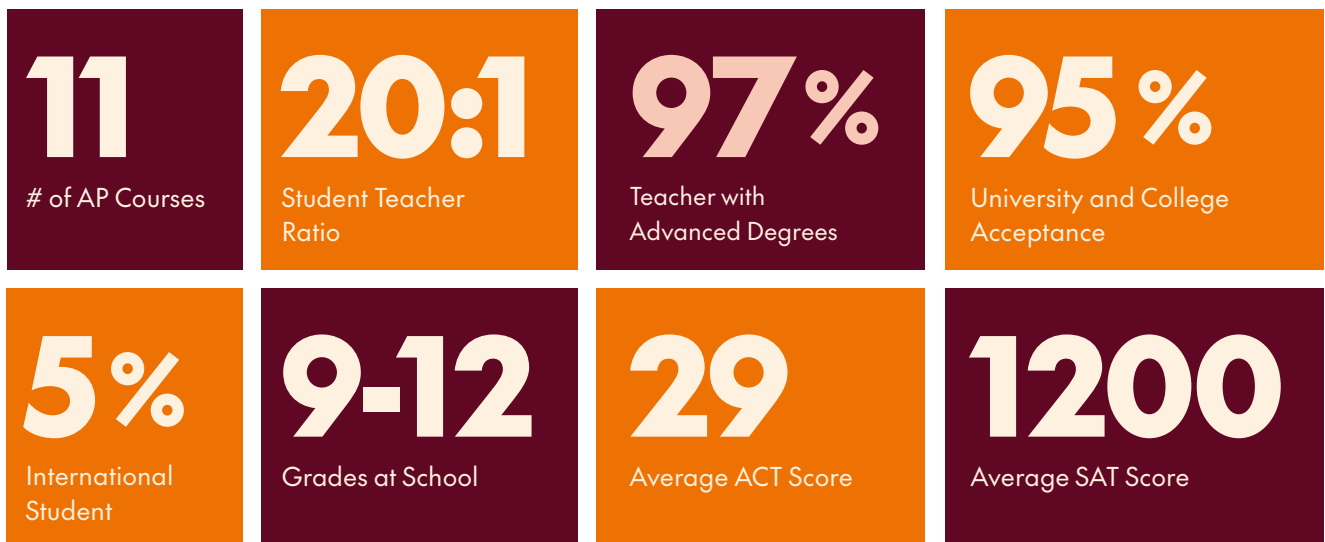

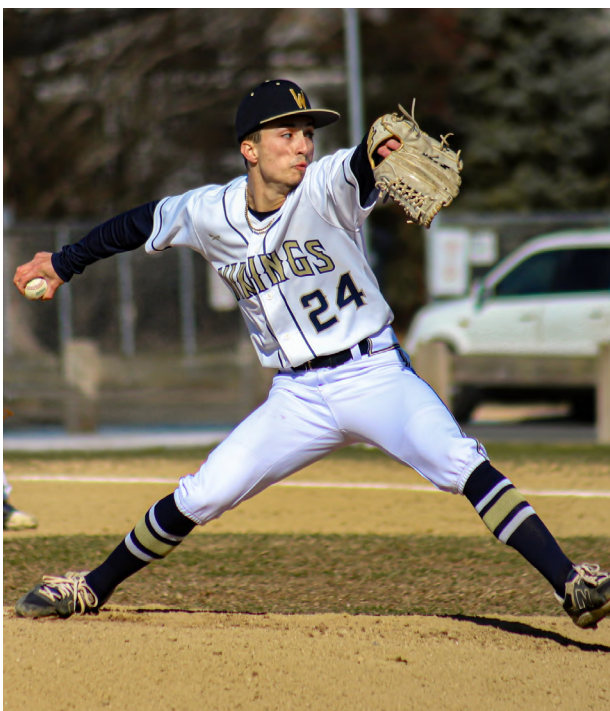
## Campus Facilities

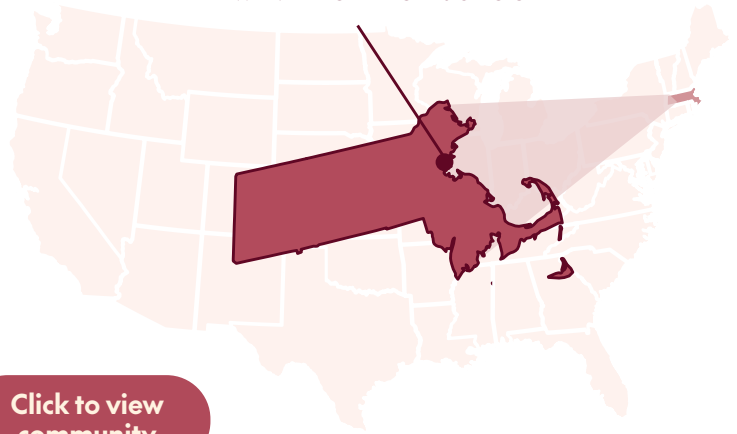
## Community
