## Campus Facilities

The Storm King School campus is set in a mountain landscape overlooking the Hudson River, providing an immersive academic and residential environment. Facilities support a full college-preparatory program, including science labs, visual and performing arts studios, and dedicated spaces for technology-based coursework. The campus layout supports close interaction among students and faculty, reinforcing the school's emphasis on community and collaboration.



## Residential Life

Students live in on-campus residence halls with a structured residential model that supports academic focus, personal responsibility, and community living. Dormitories provide shared rooms with supervised common spaces for study and social interaction. Residential life staff support students throughout the week, coordinating evening study hours, activities, and weekend programming. Boarding students represent a diverse mix of domestic and international backgrounds, creating a global residential community integrated closely with the academic program.

## Athletics and Arts

Athletics are an integral part of student life, with participation encouraged as part of the school's physical education requirement. Students compete in interscholastic and recreational sports while also engaging in outdoor and fitness-based activities that emphasize teamwork, discipline, and personal growth.

The arts program is a core academic pillar, offering extensive coursework in visual arts, performing arts, and design. Students may pursue studio art, digital design, fashion, music, and theater, with advanced opportunities in AP Studio Art and portfolio development. The program supports both creative exploration and preparation for arts-related university pathways.

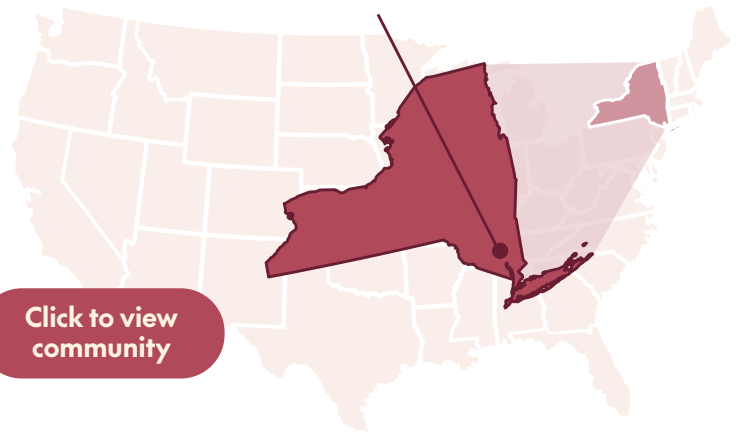
