Campus Facilities

The campus is set in Vermont's Northeast Kingdom and includes academic classrooms, science and technology labs, visual and performing arts spaces, and athletic facilities. Career and technical areas support programs such as engineering, health sciences, business, and trades. Outdoor fields and nearby natural landscapes provide space for sports and recreation throughout the year. Facilities support both boarding and day students within a single integrated campus.

Residential Life

Boarding is a core part of the school and available for grades 9–12 and postgraduate students. Students live in supervised residence halls with shared rooms and common spaces. Dining services provide daily meals on campus. Boarding students come from across the United States and multiple countries, participating fully in academics, athletics, and extracurricular activities.

Athletics and Arts

Athletics are an integral part of student life, with teams competing at interscholastic levels across multiple seasons. Students may choose from a wide range of varsity and junior varsity sports.

The arts program includes visual arts, music, and performing arts with opportunities for exhibitions and performances throughout the year.

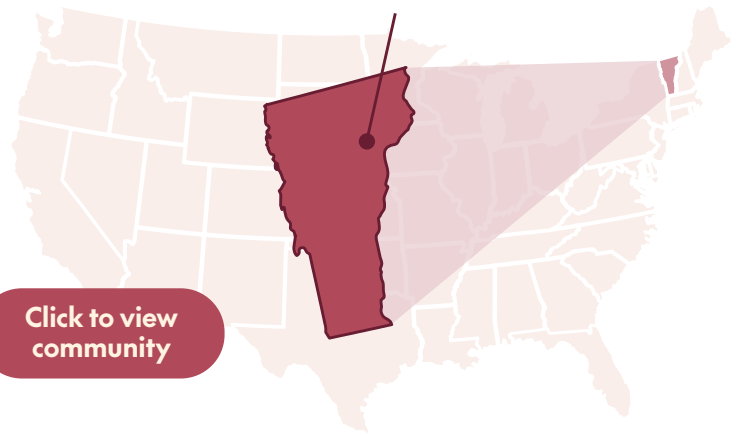
