The Upper School at The Calverton School adopts a college preparatory curriculum rooted in the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme, enabling students to engage in interdisciplinary inquiry, research, and critical thinking. Students complete a minimum of 23 credits across English, mathematics, science, world languages, social sciences, and arts, with senior internships required to support real-world readiness. The IB Programme emphasizes global perspectives, extended essay research, and Theory of Knowledge as central components that prepare students for competitive university environments. Small class sizes and individualized faculty attention support academic growth, and Upper School learners cultivate inquiry, communication, and analytical skills aligned with higher education expectations.

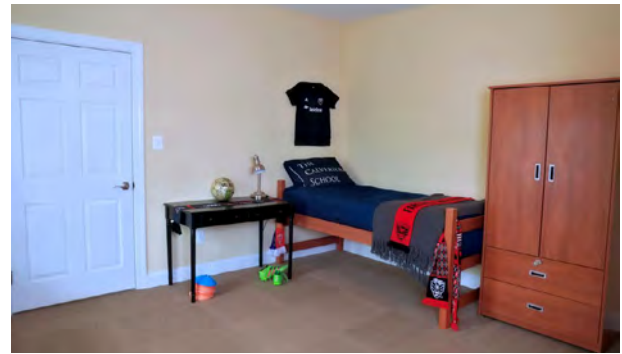
Residential Life

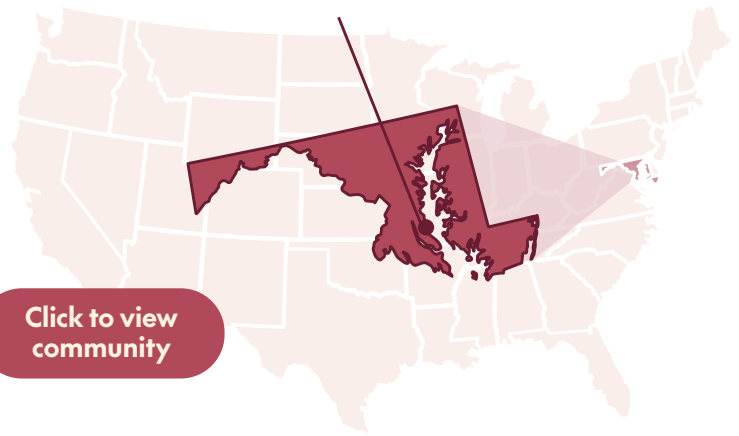
