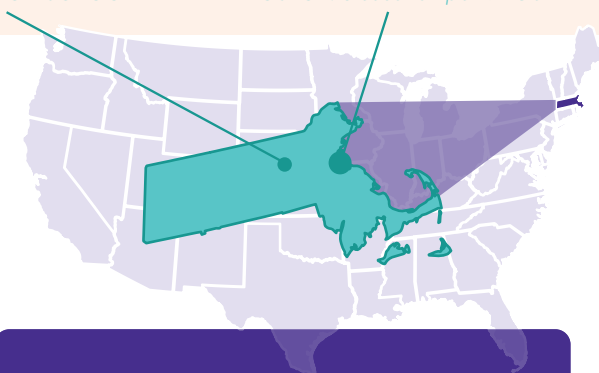

## SCHOOL PROFILE

Maynard High School is a small high school in a suburban town offering dual enrollment and AP courses, a specialized communication program, and online courses through the Virtual High School program. The Massachusetts Department of Education named Maynard High School as a "Leading the Nation" school, and Niche.com gave both the school and the community an "B" rating.

Maynard High School's facilities include a new classroom building opened in 2013, an auditorium, a cafeteria, a gymnasium, vocational technology classrooms, a radio/TV station, and a state-of-the-art athletic field complex.
