The TMI Episcopal campus occupies approximately 80 acres in northwest San Antonio, combining academic, athletic, arts, and residential spaces. Classrooms and labs support STEM, humanities, and innovation programs. Athletic facilities include fields, courts, and fitness spaces for competitive sports. Arts facilities support visual arts, music, theater, and design. Outdoor areas and green spaces are used for experiential learning and recreation. The campus environment emphasizes community, collaboration, and accessibility to both day and boarding students.

Residential Life

Boarding at TMI Episcopal is available for students in grades 8–12 within supervised residence halls. Students have shared rooms, common lounges, dining services, and structured support from residential staff. The boarding environment emphasizes academic focus, social development, and leadership through daily routines that integrate study time and community activities. Students represent domestic and international backgrounds, contributing to a diverse residential community that supports independence and peer connection.

Athletics and Arts

Athletics at TMI Episcopal includes a broad interscholastic program where students compete regionally while developing teamwork, sportsmanship, and physical fitness. Programs range across fall, winter, and spring seasons with dedicated coaching and facilities.

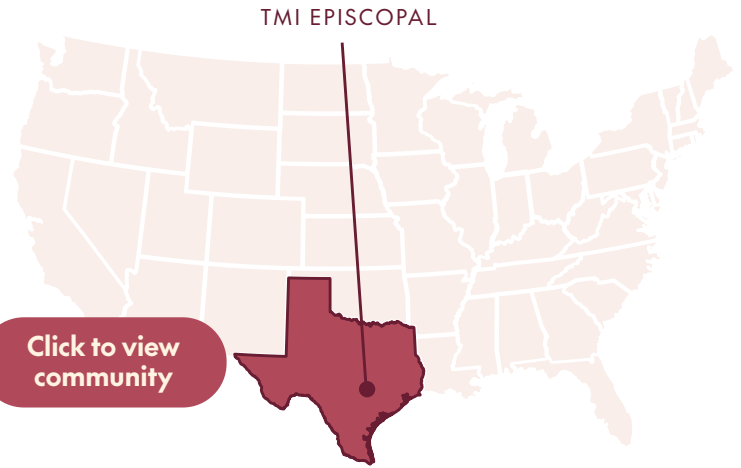
