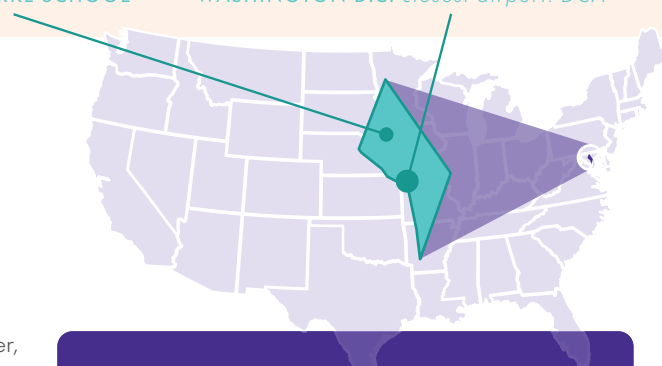
Edmund Burke offers a comprehensive art program with the understanding that painting, drawing, ceramics, music, and acting are important for student development.
