## Academic Excellence

The Woodstock Academy offers a comprehensive college-preparatory curriculum with 20+ AP courses and Early College Experience courses through the University of Connecticut, allowing students to earn transferable university credit. Faculty hold advanced degrees at a high rate. Specialized academic pathways include STEAM programs with access to 3D printers, drone technology, media studios, and applied engineering spaces. The school also provides structured support programs, including STRIVE and Therapeutic Program options, which integrate academic coursework with clinical, behavioral, and transition-to-adulthood services for eligible students. Students consistently progress to competitive universities, supported by dedicated college counseling.

## Student Accomplishments

Students at The Woodstock Academy earn AP Scholar awards, administer over 300 AP exams annually, and consistently secure admissions to competitive universities including Ivy League institutions.

## Campus Facilities

The Woodstock Academy's dual-campus setting spans more than 300 acres and features modern learning environments including a STEAM Center equipped with drones, 3D printers, simulators and a TV studio, a dedicated arts center, science labs, athletics complexes with turf fields and gymnasiums. Students live close to both academic and residential facilities in a rural New England setting, yet within driving distance of major cities.


## Residential Life



## Community


