The Beverly High School campus includes **technology-enabled classrooms, science labs, a Learning Commons, and specialized spaces for engineering, digital media, and culinary arts.**

Outdoor areas support athletics and environmental science programs. The building is modern, spacious, and designed to support collaborative and project-based learning.

Community

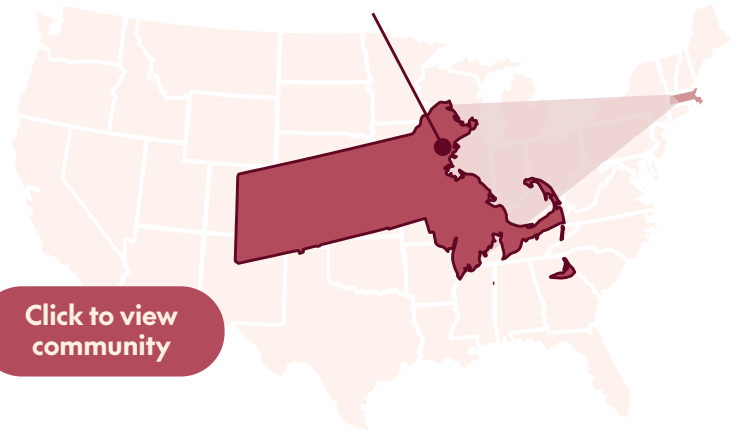
