## SCHOOL PROFILE

Montpelier High School (MHS) is a public school with 332 students from grades 9 to 12. Offering small class sizes with one teacher for every seven students, MHS offers unique programs and multiple pathways which allows students to tailor their experiences to fit their goals. They also offer a Community Based Learning Program to give students a hands on experience in the work environment.

### FACILITIES

The facilities include a 3D printer, solar panels with digital read-outs, a green house with rainwater collection, sub-irrigation, aquaponics systems, and the school lends students their own Chrome Book to use for the year. The campus and community are focused around sustainability.

### SPORTS AND ARTS

The athletics program offers opportunities for students to participate on great teams like the girls' tennis team, who won four state championships in five years.

Each year students at Montpelier demonstrate their progress in the arts with a schoolwide exhibition of artwork including anything from short films to instrumental recitals.

### AWARDS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

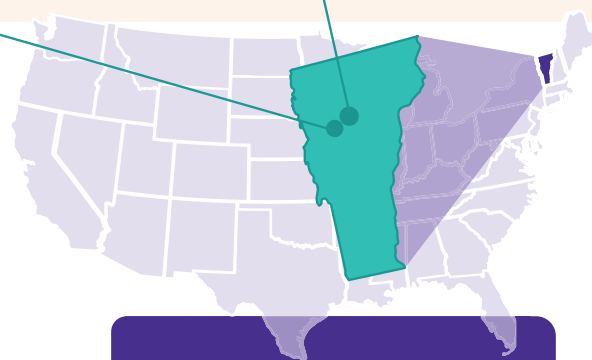
