## Academic Excellence

Brockenhurst College offers **more than 40 A Level subjects across sciences, humanities, business, languages, arts and technology.** International students achieve a **98% pass rate**, reflecting consistently strong academic performance. The college provides structured guidance to support subject selection, academic progress and university applications. In recent years, around **70% of international students progressed to a top 20 ranked UK university.** Learners benefit from specialist teaching spaces, modern IT resources and dedicated science and STEM facilities that support both academic depth and independent study.

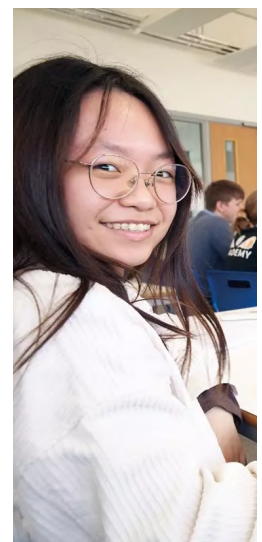
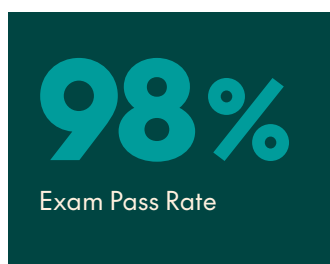
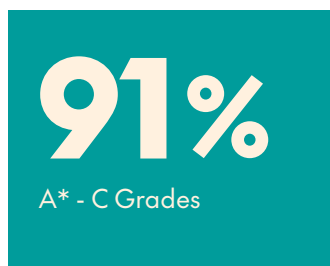

## Campus Facilities

The college is set on a 36-acre campus in the heart of the New Forest National Park. Facilities include **upgraded IT classrooms, business and media suites, art rooms, computing departments, a specialist STEM centre and new science laboratories.** Students also have access to 27 acres of playing fields, a sports centre with gym and fitness studio, a 100-seat theatre and social spaces such as the Hard Brock Café. Learning spaces support both academic study and practical project work.

## Life with local host families

International students stay with local host families arranged through Educatius. Host families are located mainly in the nearby coastal city of Bournemouth, around 30 minutes from the college. Accommodation includes **single or shared rooms, meals and daily supervision.** Students benefit from a balance of city living and study in a natural environment, with good public transport links and direct train access to London. Family First placement is available for eligible students.

## Athletics and Arts

Students can join sports academies in basketball, football, hockey, netball and rugby, with training twice a week and competition at county, regional and national levels. Additional activities are available through enrichment programmes across the year.

The arts programme includes subjects such as animation, photography and theatre technology, supported by specialist studios and creative spaces. Students can explore different creative areas through short-term enrichment courses and practical projects.

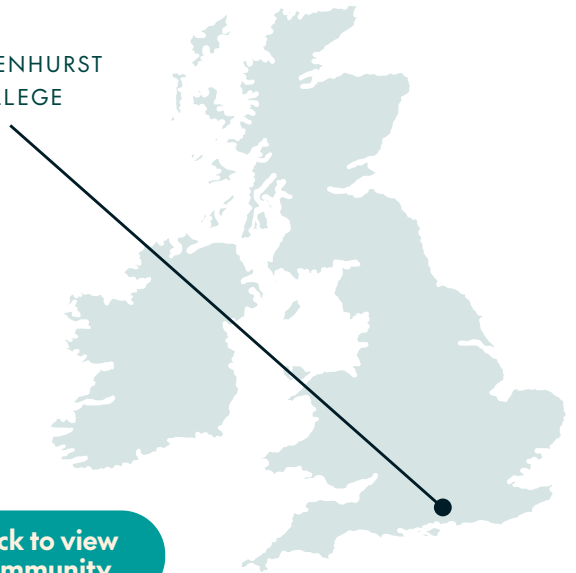
## Community
