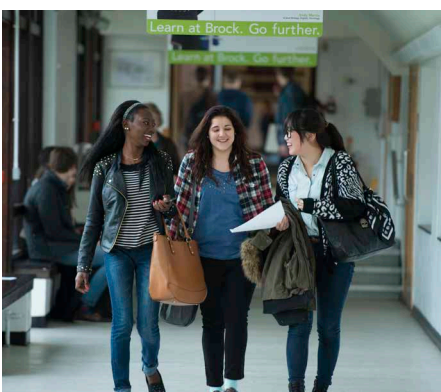

BROCKENHURST

Located in the heart of the New Forest National Park situated between Lyndhurst and Lymington, Brockenhurst is a bustling village. The New Forest boasts wild ponies and donkeys roaming free in an old world setting full of charm. Brockenhurst, or 'Brock' as it is known to the locals, is characterised by its Georgian and Victorian red brick building.

Educatus Host Families for Brockenhurst College are located in Bournemouth. Students take the train from Bournemouth to Brockenhurst which takes about 25-30 mins.

Students appreciate the opportunity to be living in a vibrant seaside city whilst studying at a school in such a beautiful setting. Because of the location of the school the campus closes at 5pm daily so that students are able to travel home so there's no 'missing out' on campus activities if students need to travel.

SPORTS ACADEMY

You can continue playing the sports you love and develop as an athlete by joining the Sports Academy at Brockenhurst College. Here you will benefit from regular coaching, training and frequent competition. STEM CENTRE

Their ultra-modern £4.7million STEM Centre opened in 2017. As well as being home to their Maths department, the STEM Centre is a key teaching and learning venue for Science, Technology and Engineering subjects. There is also a large Mac suite, an open plan study area and Skills Development rooms. The new building was commended by the New Forest National Park Authority in 2019, with leaders calling it an 'excellent piece of modern design'.

STATE-OF-THE-ART FACILITIES

Brockenhurst have invested consistently in IT assets to make sure their students always have access to up-to-date learning tools.

Many classrooms have undergone significant IT upgrades, including the Business suite, Media rooms, Art rooms and IT & Computing department.
