Bexhill-On-Sea, or Bexhill for short, is a small, safe and friendly seaside town on the southcoast of England. The town has a stunning coastline with a long promenade and an award-winning clean beach. In addition, the town features the famous 1930s-designed De La Warr Pavilion where visitors flock to enjoy coastal views over Eastbourne and Hastings, live music, contemporary artand cultural events.
