Academic Excellence

Bexhill College offers one of the broadest Sixth Form selections in the region, with A Levels, BTEC qualifications, GCSEs, T Levels, the Extended Project Qualification and University Foundation routes available to students. The college reports strong academic performance, including a 94% A*–C grade rate for 16–18 learners. Specialist provision includes science laboratories, a professional theatre complex, music and media studios, and a dedicated science academy offering additional coaching and mentoring. Students can combine academic and vocational courses to suit their goals and receive structured guidance for university progression. Graduates have progressed to leading universities such as Oxford, Cambridge, King’s College London and the University of Bristol.

Campus Facilities

All facilities at Bexhill College are located on one main campus, allowing students to move between academic and practical sessions easily. The college provides science laboratories, a recording studio, a TV studio, media production spaces, a modern gym and fitness area, a 3G football pitch, a climbing wall and access to a neighbouring swimming pool. Creative students use rehearsal rooms, performance spaces and a 200-seat theatre complex. Study areas and common spaces support collaborative learning and enrichment across academic and vocational programmes.

Life with local host families

Students live with vetted host families in Bexhill and surrounding areas. Accommodation generally includes single or shared rooms, meals and adult supervision. Host families offer a practical base for day-to-day study and help students become familiar with local customs. Public transport links provide easy access to the college. Family First placements are available to provide additional stability for younger or first-time international students.

Athletics and Arts

Bexhill College offers extensive sporting opportunities, supported by specialist academies across multiple disciplines. Students can access indoor and outdoor facilities, coaching pathways and competitive opportunities through regional college leagues.

Creative students benefit from dedicated spaces for music, art, drama, dance and film. The Performing Arts Academy and theatre complex provide further opportunities for skill development and public performance.

Bexhill-on-Sea is a small coastal town in South East England known for its long beachfront promenade and clean, award-winning beach.
