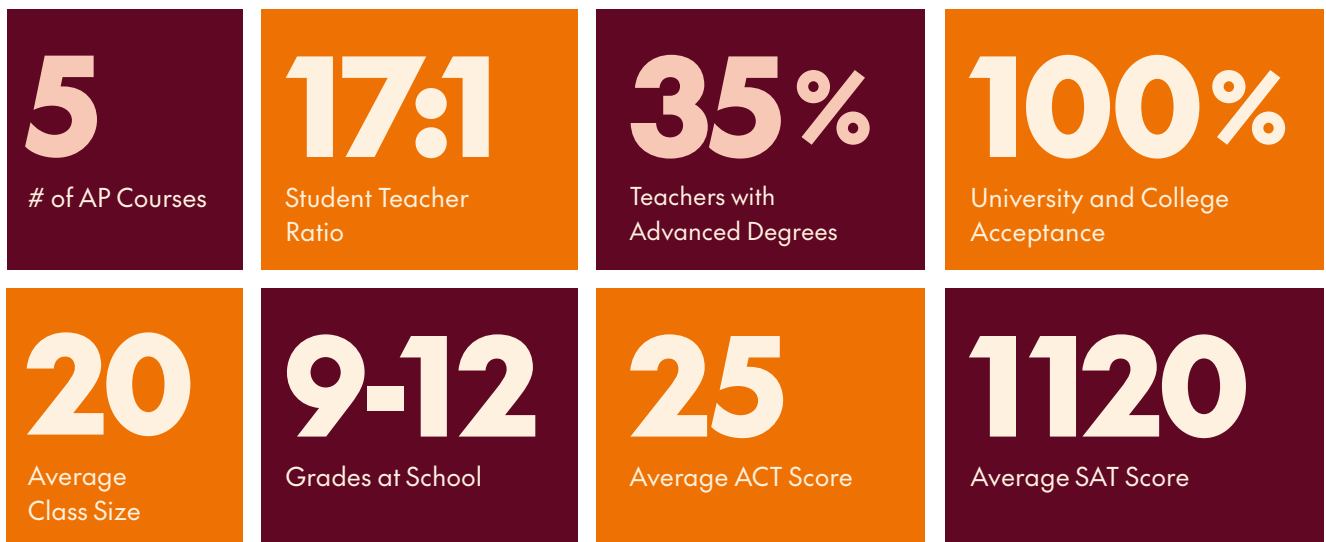

Campus Facilities

The 67-acre campus includes **academic buildings, science labs, and technology-equipped classrooms** that support both traditional study and hands-on learning. Facilities for the arts include dedicated spaces for choir, band, and visual arts. Athletic resources feature a gymnasium, stadium, baseball and softball fields, soccer fields, and a track. Specialized areas for agriculture, horticulture, and animal science provide practical learning environments connected to the school's agricultural program. Outdoor spaces, including fields and walking areas, contribute to a supportive and active campus environment.

Athletics and Arts

Athens Christian has a strong athletic tradition with competitive teams across multiple sports. Students participate in regional and state-level competitions, supported by experienced coaches and well-maintained athletic facilities.

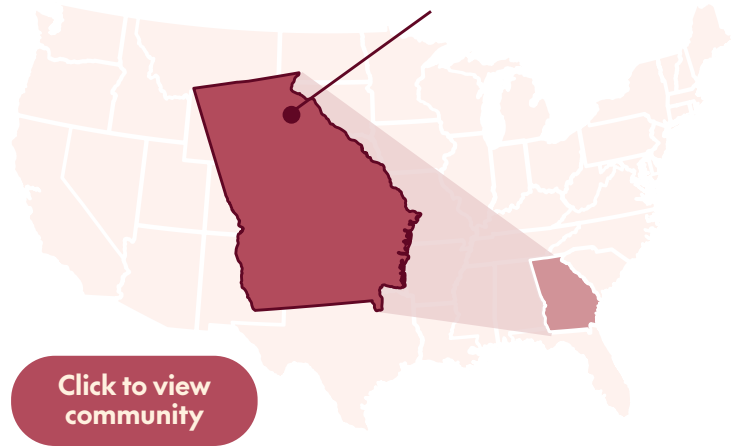
