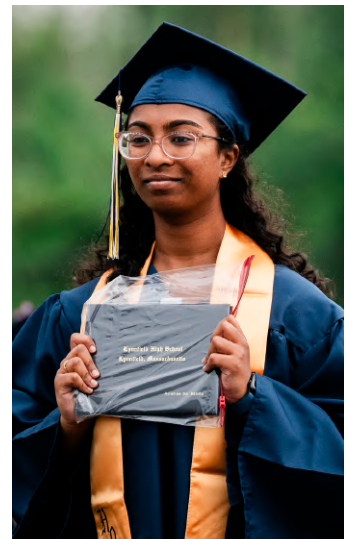

## Campus Facilities

Lynnfield High School provides **modern facilities** that support academic, artistic, and athletic development. 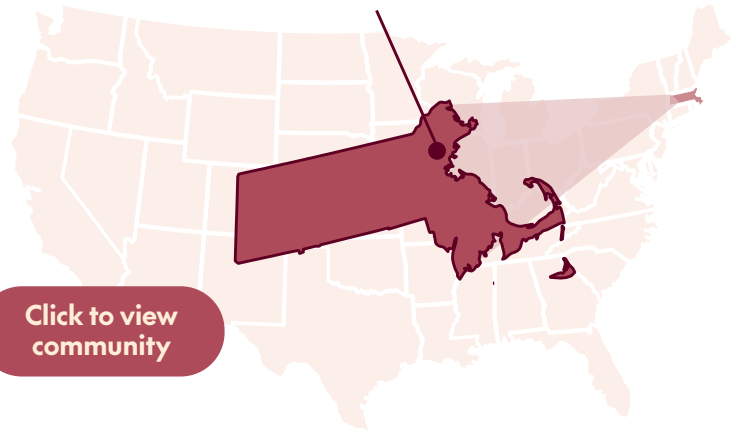
