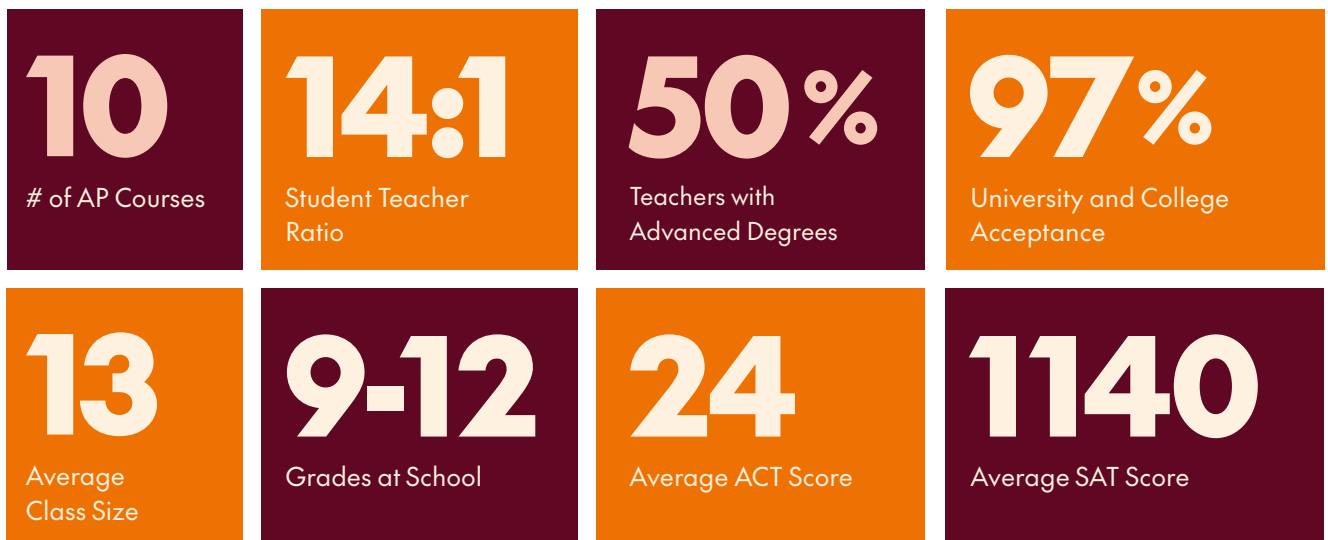

Campus Facilities

The campus provides **purpose-built academic and activity spaces** that support both classroom learning and extracurricular engagement. Facilities include **science labs, technology-enabled classrooms, art studios, music rehearsal areas, and athletic training spaces**. Shared student areas encourage collaboration, while athletic fields and indoor courts support daily practices and competitive events.

Athletics and Arts

Athletics are a core part of student life, with a high percentage of students participating in team sports. Programs emphasize commitment, teamwork, and physical development through regular training and competitive schedules. Students compete in sports such as football, basketball, soccer, baseball, volleyball, wrestling, and track and field.

The arts program provides a structured pathway to deepen their skills while still engaging in a demanding academic curriculum. Students are encouraged to nurture their creativity as a meaningful form of expression. Throughout the year, students have opportunities to present their work through exhibitions and performances in visual art, music, and drama.

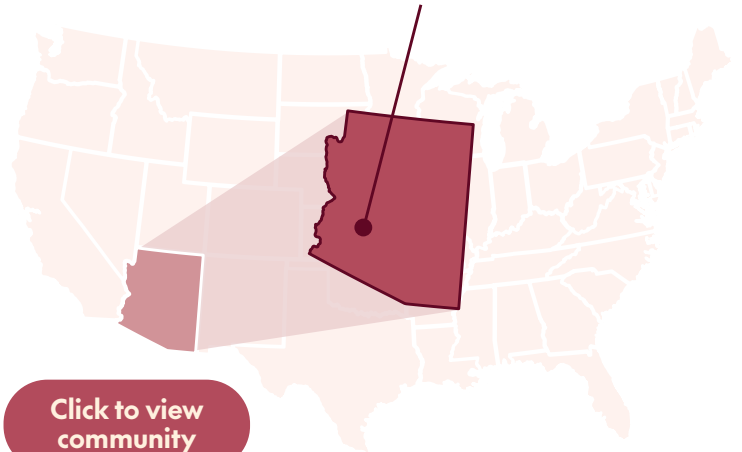
