SPORTS AND ARTS

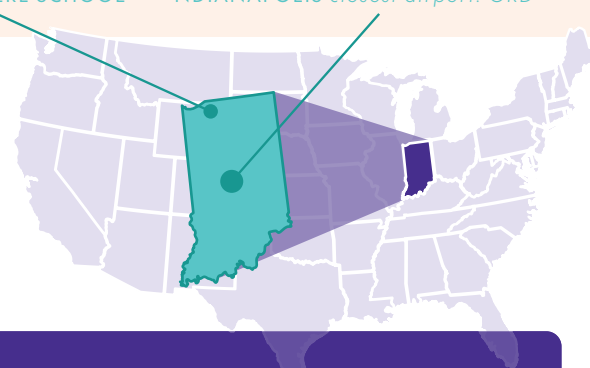
