Campus Facilities

The campus is set in a coastal Maine town and integrates academic buildings, science labs, art studios, performance spaces, and technology classrooms within a walkable setting. Students have access to dedicated spaces for engineering, design, and applied learning, as well as areas for visual and performing arts. Athletic fields and fitness spaces support seasonal sports and wellness programs. The surrounding natural environment is used as an extended classroom for environmental study and community-based learning.

Residential Life

Lincoln Academy offers a residential program alongside its day school. Boarding students live in supervised residences with shared rooms and common areas designed for study and social interaction. Dining services provide daily meals on campus, and evening programming supports academic routines and community life. Residential students come from across the United States and multiple countries, creating an international boarding environment within a town academy setting.

Athletics and Arts

Athletics are an integral part of student life, with opportunities for participation at varsity and junior varsity levels. Teams compete regionally and emphasize skill development, teamwork, and balance with academics.

The arts program includes visual arts, music, and theater, allowing students to pursue both introductory and advanced study. Coursework emphasizes technique, creative process, and performance or exhibition, with opportunities to participate in ensembles and productions.

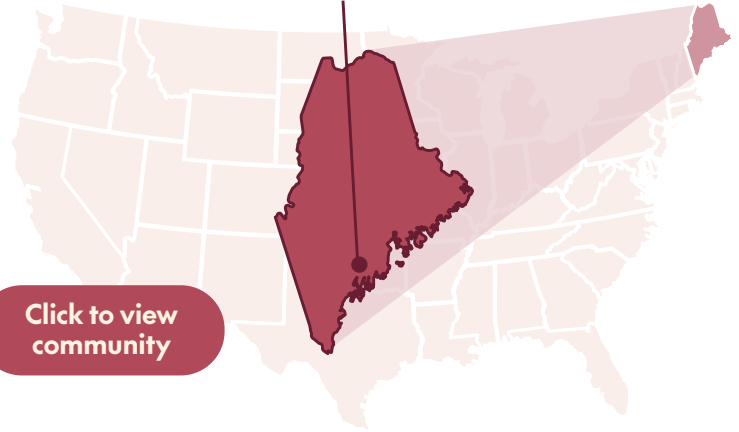
