Rosny College has established a strong reputation for academic excellence. In 2013, four students from Rosny College were among the top 100 Tasmanian academic performers, each achieving an Australian Tertiary Admissions Rank (ATAR) of 98.4 or above

Students in years 11 and 12 are able to select subjects from a wide range of course areas. Subjects are accredited by the Tasmanian Qualifications Authority and are offered at both a “university-entrance” level (level 3), or at a foundation level (level 2).

Rosny College also provides a wide range of nationally-recognised vocational (VET) programs for students wishing to pursue further studies at a training institution such as TasTAFE.

Teaching staff will assist students in selecting the subjects that are most appropriate or required for future university or vocational studies.

Advanced Academic Programs

Rosny College provides learning support for students on an academic pathway through subject-based tutorials and access to the University College and the Rosny High Achievers program.

The Rosny High Achievers Program supports academically-gifted students. In this program, students will receive extra assistance in exam preparation, learn about available scholarships, and meet with other students also wishing to gain the most from their academic studies.

The University College Program allows students to undertake university subjects while studying for their Tasmanian Certificate of Education in areas such as languages, creative arts, music and more
