Seccina Memorial High School provides a rigorous college-preparatory curriculum that includes honors, Advanced Placement, and extensive dual-credit options through partnerships with Indiana colleges. Students benefit from small classes and guidance from qualified faculty who support academic growth across STEM, humanities, and arts pathways. The school integrates Catholic teachings while maintaining a strong focus on college readiness, literacy refinement, and service learning. Engineering and biomedical sciences are offered through Project Lead the Way, and international students have access to ESL support and structured academic advising. Graduates matriculate to universities across the United States, supported by a dedicated counseling program and opportunities for advanced coursework and academic enrichment.

Campus Facilities

The campus includes modern classrooms, STEM and biomedical labs, a media center, art studios, and facilities for engineering and technology courses. Athletic spaces include a gymnasium, outdoor fields, and training areas that support year-round sports. Theology, performing arts, and music programs use dedicated instructional rooms. Collaborative spaces and updated technology support project-based learning and dual-credit coursework. Outdoor areas and nearby community resources provide additional enrichment opportunities for students.

Athletics and Arts

Secina features a competitive athletic program with multiple varsity and junior varsity teams. Students train in well-maintained indoor and outdoor facilities and participate in conference and statewide competitions. The program emphasizes teamwork, skill development, and sportsmanship, offering opportunities across all seasons.

The arts program includes visual arts, choir, band, theater, digital media, and creative writing. Students develop skills through performance opportunities, studio work, and courses that support portfolio creation and expressive growth.


