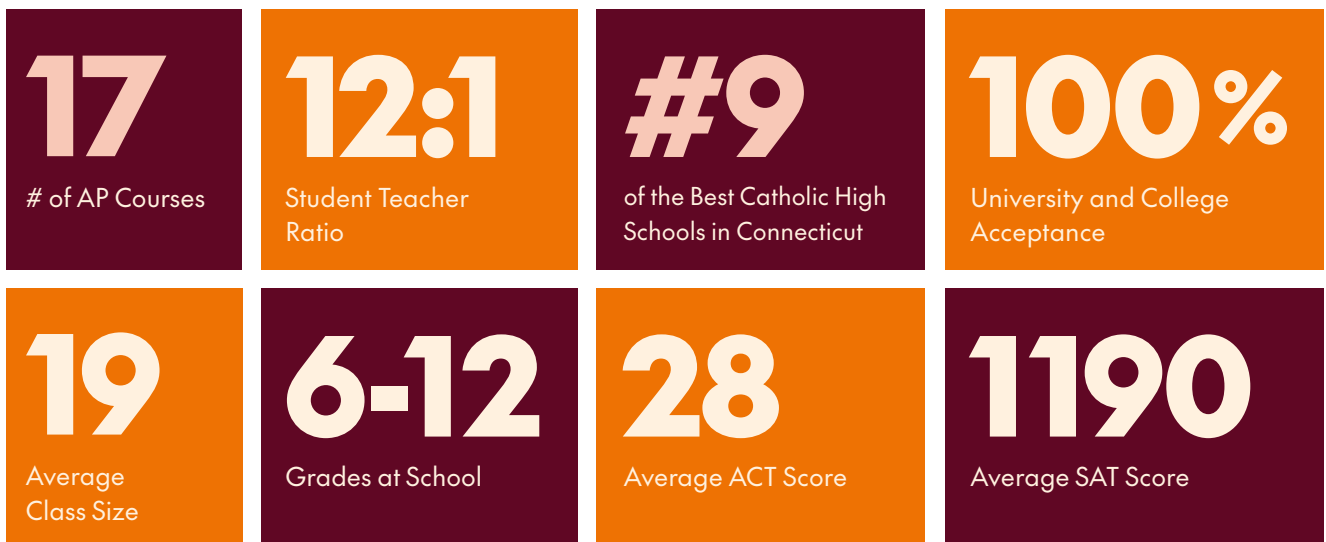

## Campus Facilities

The 113-acre campus includes **modern academic buildings, science laboratories, language and technology suites, arts studios, and dedicated spaces for theater and music.** Athletic facilities are extensive, featuring fields for soccer, lacrosse, and baseball, as well as a gymnasium for basketball, volleyball, and indoor training. The campus provides open green spaces, collaborative learning areas, and specialized rooms that support STEM, arts, and extracurricular activities. These facilities create a well-resourced environment that enhances both academic and student life.

## Athletics and Arts

Saint Bernard competes in a broad range of interscholastic sports and maintains strong participation in seasonal athletics. Students develop teamwork, discipline, and physical skill through structured training and conference competition.

The arts program includes visual arts, music, and theater, providing opportunities for creative expression and performance. Students explore various media through courses in drawing, painting, sculpture, photography, design, and acting. Music offerings include choir, jazz band, guitar, music theory, and string ensemble, supported by dedicated rehearsal and performance spaces.

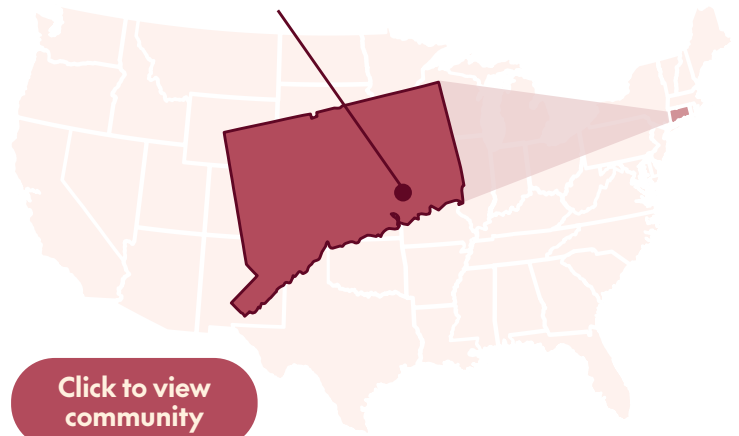
