The award-winning music department has performed at Disneyland, Times Square, and Carnegie Hall.

AWARDS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

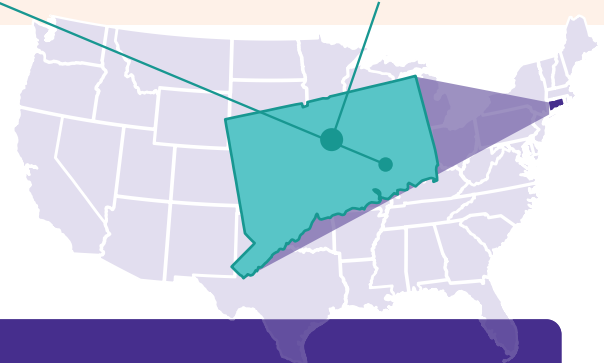
