





Students will be integrated into the Campus Sainte Therese high school for 3 years. They will study in Seconde, Première & Terminale, (equivalent to years 10 to 12).

• Students are welcomed into existing classes with French students around their age. They will be placed according to their level and subjects of interest.

•With a focus on obtaining the "Baccalauréat", essential for university studies in France:

- 100% of students in Sainte Therese obtain their "Baccalauréat", 90% with a merit,

- 30% of which have a « very good » merit (general average of 16/20 or more).

• During the 3 years of schooling, students will benefit from guidance coaching to help them choose the best path through to higher education.

Situated in Ozoir-La-Ferrière, 45 minutes from the heart of Paris, 10 minutes from Disneyland Paris and 15 minutes from Roissy-Charles de Gaulle airport.

The campus welcomes 1000 middle school students (Sixième to Troisième / years 6 to 9) and 500 high school students (Seconde to Terminale / years 10 to 12).

Premiere & Terminale (Year 11 & 12)

The "classe de Première" introduces specialty teachings while keeping a significant amount of compulsory core subjects. Students must choose 3 additional subjects (4 hours per week per subject). Students can choose one option.

The "classe de Terminale" reinforces specialization from a higher education perspective. Students must choose 2 additional subjects (6 hours per week per subject). Students can choose one option.

OUR BOARDING SCHOOL

International students are welcomed in a luxury boarding school with twin rooms. It is however possible to optionally request an individual bedroom.

Students will full board for 270 nights per year, with 3 hot meals a day. All allergies and special diets are taken into account, without extra charge.

Bedroom and bath linen (sheets and 2 towels per person) are supplied and changed every Monday.

For personal laundry, washing machines are available. Boys and girls sleep on separate floors. Students are cared for 24/7.

HEALTH AND MEDICAL INSURANCE

The school uses the services of a local doctor, who can be called at anytime. European students do not have to pay any medical insurance. They do however need to be in possession of their European Health Insurance Card. Non-European students will need to take out a compulsory health insurance with JEV (see price list). Civil responsibility and repatriation insurance should be taken out by all students.

LOCAL AND REGIONAL TRANSPORT

It is recommended that students subscribe to a « Navigo pass » which will enable them to travel around the whole Paris region at a monthly fixed price.
