Première & Terminale (Year 11 & 12)



The "classe de Première" introduces specialty teachings while keeping a significant amount of compulsory core subjects. Students must choose 3 additional subjects (4 hours per week per subject) and one option (3 hours per week per subject).

The "classe de Terminale" reinforces specialization from a higher education perspective. Students must choose 2 additional subjects (6 hours per week per subject) and two options (3 hours per week per subject).
