

Dewitt High School has excellent academics, a number of extracurricular activities, and plenty of athletic and art opportunities. The school offers dual-credit enrollment with local community colleges, as well as Michigan State University, and it's also the home to the DeWitt Creativity Group, an inclusive group which encourages students to innovate through projects in the arts, entrepreneurship, and STEM.
