Fulneck School is an independent co- educational boarding school in a truly unique setting in beautiful Yorkshire. BOARDING AT FULNECK

Boarding at Fulneck School is homely, supportive, flexible and fun. The school's two boarding houses - one for girls and one for boys - are both located in the main school building, creating a very safe and secure environment. The school aims to provide a 'home from home' experience to ensure that the transition into boarding life is as seamless as possible for both UK and international students. The care and wellbeing of all students is the number one priority of the houseparents, matrons and academic staff, who make sure that a well-balanced and structured routine is in place. The girls' house accommodates 36 boarders and the boys' house accommodates 50. Both houses have single, twin and triple bedrooms as well as well-equipped common room areas and kitchens. Weekends are jam-packed with events and there is always a varied timetable of activities on offer such as trips to shopping centres, parks, museums, outdoor activity centres and much much more. Nestled between glorious Yorkshire countryside and the city of Leeds, boarders have the perfect British balance of enjoying both country and city life.

Fulneck School is lucky enough to be situated within 20 miles of four of the UK's largest universities; The University of Leeds, Leeds Beckett University, The University of Bradford and The University of Huddersfield.

TEACHING FROM INDUSTRY EXPERTS

Many of the teaching staff at Fulneck School are experts in their respective industries with many years of experience behind them. This allows students to learn from the best and develop a strong understanding of their desired career pathway. They benefit from 1-2-1 tuition to guide them in the development of the skills and knowledge required to progress to university level study.

FAMILY ATMOSPHERE

Fulneck is a small yet diverse community with a family feel. The school ethos of showing kindness to all means that all students are made to feel quickly at home. Upon entering the senior school, each student is assigned to one of three Houses- Asquith, Oastler or Wolstenholme – and they will remain part of that family until they leave for university. Fulneck Houses are organised into vertical tutor groups in order to allow the students to mix with others from different year groups and the older students act as guides and mentors to the younger ones.

MODERN SIXTH FORM FACILITIES

Fulneck Sixth Form students spend their study time in the brand new Sixth Form study centre, complete with a suite of computers, a comfortable common room area and a modern kitchen- all separate from the main school.
