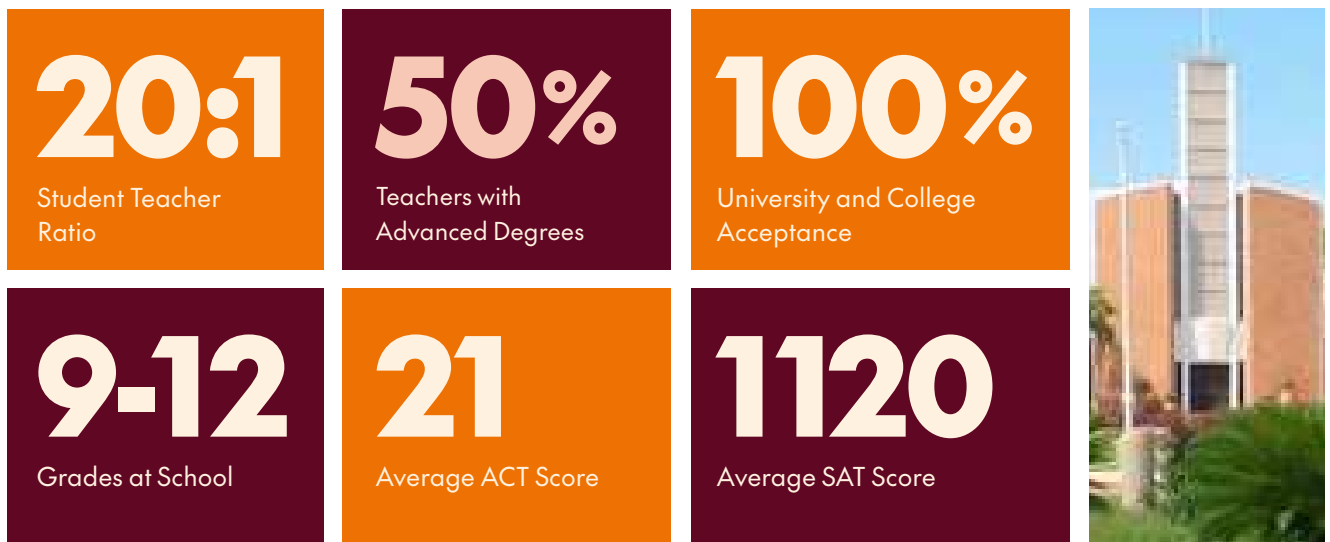

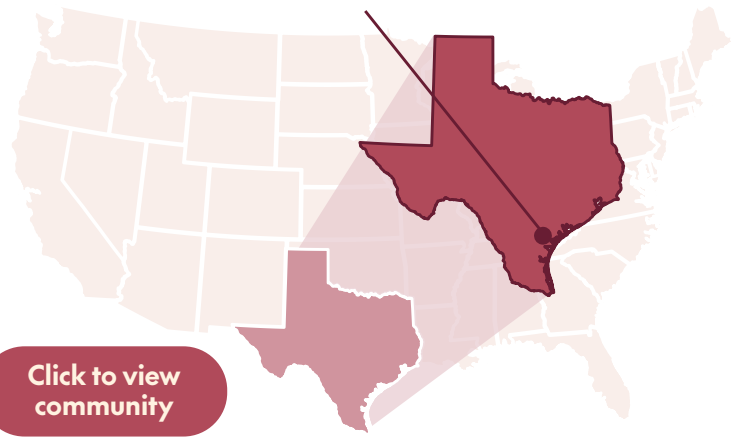

Community

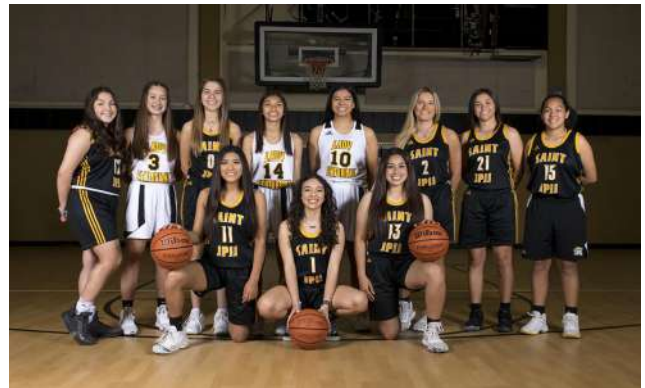
