## Academic Excellence

Havant College offers **over 40 A Level subjects**, providing one of the widest subject ranges in the region. Students achieve a 99% A Level pass rate, with 50% gaining grades A–C. The curriculum includes **science, humanities, business, creative arts and technology**, allowing students to build a tailored academic pathway. Study programmes include five hours of teaching per subject each week, giving students more contact time than many other local colleges. Learners also benefit from opportunities to develop analytical, research and communication skills that support university preparation. Many graduates progress to competitive universities, including Russell Group institutions.

## Campus Facilities

The campus includes dance studios, science laboratories, recording studios, a fully equipped gym, a 4G Astro pitch, art studios, study centres and libraries. Students also have access to a sensory room, dedicated social spaces, a student lounge and outdoor seating areas. Academic and technical areas provide specialist rooms for media, photography and performance. The campus is well connected to Portsmouth, offering easy access to the wider region.

## Life with local host families

International students live with local host families arranged through Educatius. Accommodation includes **single or shared rooms, meals and regular supervision**. Host families support students with daily routines and provide a safe, English-speaking home environment. Most homes are located within a short commute of the college, and students experience everyday life in the local community. Family First placement is available for eligible students.

## Athletics and Arts

Students can take part in a varied sports programme with opportunities for both recreational and competitive activity. Training is supported by indoor and outdoor facilities, including a gym and all-weather pitch.

The arts programme offers practical creative work in dedicated studios and performance spaces. Students can join projects and workshops that help build skills and confidence in different artistic areas.

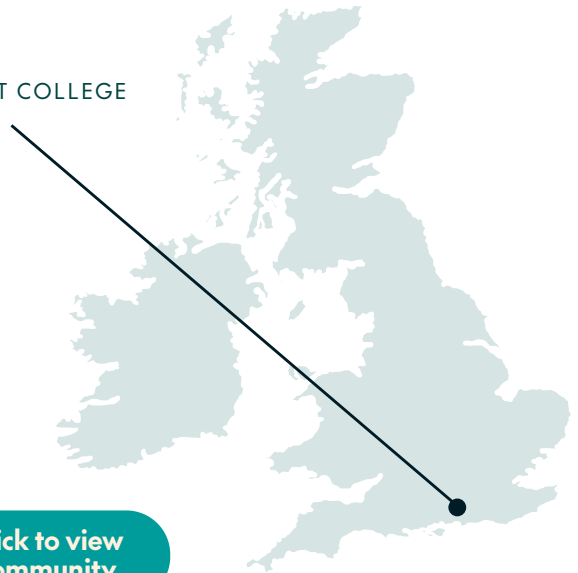
## Community
