Malden Catholic's campus features **modern science laboratories, a media center, and a newly developed Learning Commons** designed to support both collaborative and independent study. 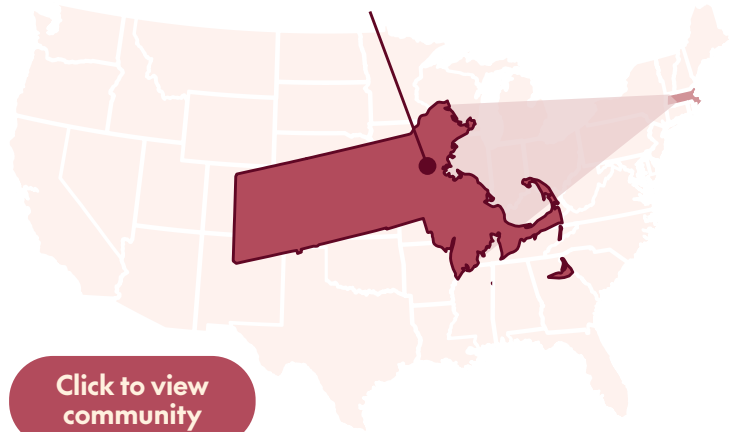
