PROJECT 150

Designed to coincide with and to extend beyond the 150th anniversary since Dover College's foundation in 1871, Project 150 heralds a 10-year period of transformational change at the school. It proposes significant investment and work on the school's curriculum and the further development of teachina and learning, alongside the enhancement of the extracurricular provision. The project also aims to maximise the use of the college's site by building the new Timothy Cobb Centre for Performing Arts and a new multi-use AstroTurf pitch and sports pavilion on the Farthingloe ground. A fundamental theme of Dover College's development is that it aims to make much of its location at the heart of the town in terms of not just offering excellent education, but also working in partnership with local people in creative arts, sports and charitable activities.

OUSTANDING SUPPORT FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students receive a warm welcome at Dover College. In addition to strong pastoral care and academic guidance, they also receive English language tuition as part of their timetable and take Cambridge International Exams. Sixth Form students also study for the IELTS exam which is required for entry into a UK university.

STATE-OF-THE-ART FACILITIES
