## Campus Facilities

Saint Andrew's School operates on an 81-acre campus in Boca Raton featuring dedicated academic spaces for science, technology, engineering, and mathematics; purpose-built arts studios; and collaborative learning environments. Athletic facilities support a wide range of sports with fields, courts, a swimming pool, and fitness resources. Outdoor areas include landscaped spaces for study and community activities. Residential houses provide boarding students with common areas and support spaces fostering community. The campus blends academic, athletic, and creative facilities to support year-round student growth and engagement.

## Residential Life

Upper-school boarding houses provide shared living rooms, study areas, and supervised environments. Staff mentors support academic progress, personal development, and social activities. Students participate in weekend programming and community engagement. Dining facilities serve balanced meals. Residential life emphasizes inclusivity and collaboration, encouraging students to build relationships across grades and cultural backgrounds.

## Athletics and Arts

Saint Andrew's sponsors competitive athletics with 19 sports and 65 teams, including swimming, tennis, soccer, lacrosse, and more spanning all seasons. Student athletes compete in interscholastic leagues, with accomplishments at regional and state levels.

Arts at Saint Andrew's include visual arts, studio art, and performing arts integrated into academic and extracurricular programs. Students engage in art history, creative projects, exhibitions, and performance opportunities that enhance artistic development and college preparation.

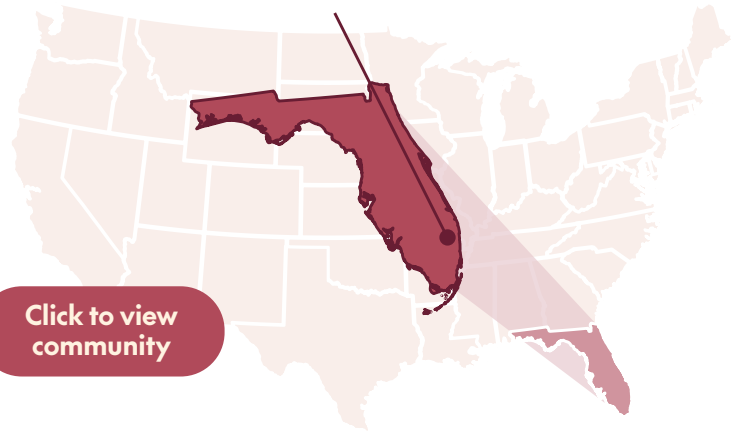
