Hebron Academy occupies a 1,500-acre campus featuring forests, lakes, and extensive trail systems used for academics and recreation. The school includes modern STEM learning spaces, science laboratories, visual and performing arts studios, and a fully equipped athletic center. Outdoor areas support environmental studies, winter sports, and experiential education. Residential and academic facilities are integrated to create a close-knit learning environment that supports both structured study and independent exploration.

Residential Life

Hebron Academy offers a traditional boarding program with on-campus housing for students in grades 6–12. Students live in supervised dormitories with shared common spaces designed for study and social interaction. Dining services provide daily meals on campus. Boarding students come from across the United States and multiple countries, creating a diverse residential community supported by faculty advisors and residential staff.

Athletics and Arts

Athletics are an integral part of student life at Hebron Academy, emphasizing participation, skill development, and teamwork. Students may compete in multiple sports across fall, winter, and spring seasons, using modern indoor and outdoor facilities and extensive natural terrain.

The arts program includes courses across visual and performing disciplines, encouraging creative expression and technical skill development through studio work, performance, and interdisciplinary projects.

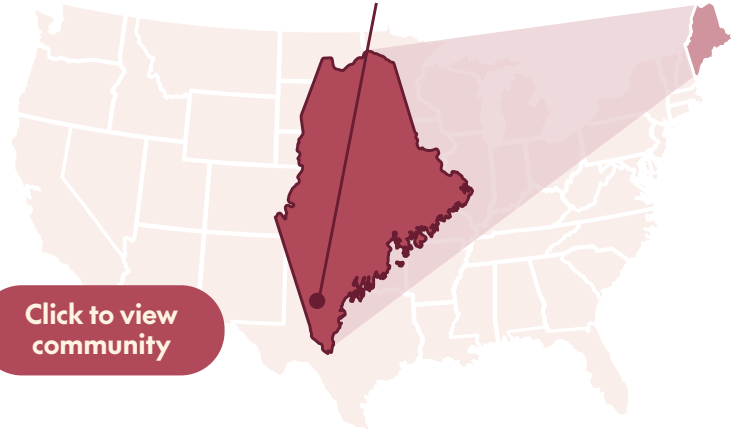
Community
