CREWE

Crewe is situated in the beautiful county of Cheshire, famous for its stunning countryside and quaint towns and villages. Originally not much more than a village Crewe developed rapidly as a railway hub in the mid-1800s, acting as a major junction on the west coastline. In the towns nearby to Crewe there is plenty to do - including indoor Go Karting, a swimming pool, a Nerf Zone, Go Ape and lots of shops and restaurants. If you fancy a day out in one of the local cities, you can easily travel to Manchester, Chester and Liverpool with journey times less than an hour. In Crewe, Queens Park has recently undergone a multimillion-pound restoration to restore and modernise it for modern lifestyles. The 44 acre park has a boating lake, fountains, a clock tower, running streams and a Pavillion with a café.



SPORTS ACADEMIES

Cheshire College believes that students shouldn't have to choose between their studies and the sport they are passionate about. The college provides talented student athletes with the opportunity to combine an outstanding education with high quality coaching in either Football, Netball, Basketball, Athletics or Boxing.
