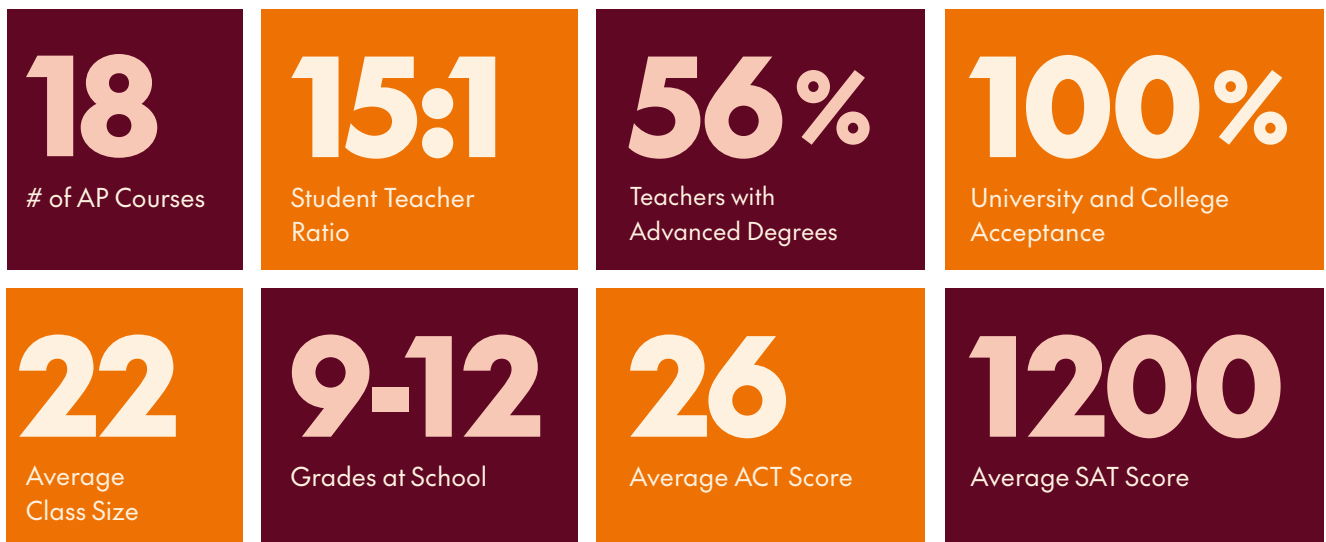

Campus Facilities

The 40-acre campus includes **eight academic buildings, modern classrooms, science labs, a media and technology center, and dedicated arts spaces.** Athletic facilities include multiple outdoor fields, a gymnasium, and a field house that supports training and competition. The campus also features a chapel that serves as a central gathering space for reflection and community activities. Facilities are designed to support both academic instruction and extracurricular engagement across disciplines.

Athletics are an important part of student life at Melbourne Central Catholic, with 23 varsity sports offered. Teams compete in a moderately competitive environment and have earned multiple state championships over the years. The program emphasizes teamwork, discipline, and balanced student development alongside academics.

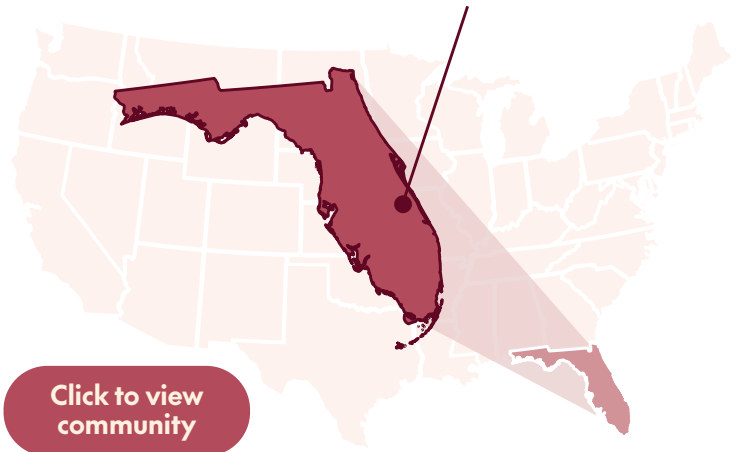
