
Residential Life




Community

Collegeville is a peaceful lakeside community of about 3,000 residents in central Minnesota. Just 12 miles from St. Cloud and 70 miles from Minneapolis-Saint Paul International Airport (MSP), it offers safe surroundings and easy access to cultural and recreational opportunities, including theaters, hiking trails, and campus events.

Climate in Minnesota

Collegeville experiences a four-season continental climate, with cold, snowy winters and mild, pleasant summers. Average high temperatures range from $20^{\circ}F$ ($-6^{\circ}C$) in January to $80^{\circ}F$ ($27^{\circ}C$) in July, with about 28 inches (710 mm) of annual precipitation.
