Avondale College provides an outstanding quality of education within one of New Zealand's biggest and best secondary schools.



Our co-educational college has all the advantages of size yet offers all the warmth, encouragement and intimacy of a small school. The facilities and setting are second to none and the teaching is of the very highest standard.

Our student body of over 2,600 includes 150 international students who come to our college for the high quality of education that is on offer both in English language and in the broader academic curriculum.

We offer both NCEA and Cambridge pathways and our focus at Avondale College is on academic success for all our students. Our aim is to provide the education best suited to the needs of our students and the community that we serve. We stress the importance of an academic curriculum supported by all the sporting, social and cultural aspects of education.

In recent years Avondale has achieved top academic results in the NCEA, Scholarship and Cambridge examinations – including students who came first in the world (Applied ICT 2013; Psychology 2012), and first in New Zealand (Psychology 2013; Physics, Biology, Chemistry and Accounting 2012). In 2013 two of our international students were the Top Scholars in New Zealand's prestigious Scholarship exams for German and French.

We prepare our students for future opportunities in the tertiary education sector and in all vocational areas including commerce, trade and the professions.

We expect students to develop respect for self, for others and for property and we applaud such standards and values as honesty, integrity, courtesy, concern for others, perseverance and hard work. Students are expected to participate in all areas of school life and to represent the College in sporting teams and cultural activities.



EXCELLENT ACADEMIC FOUNDATION

The Avondale College international programme is first and foremost, an academic programme. We offer a top quality education to all our students, covering the essential learning areas. More than 80% of our students achieve New Zealand's University Entrance qualification, and the majority of our students go on to pursue further education at a university in New Zealand or overseas.

Students are encouraged to achieve personal excellence by studying subjects in depth to expand their knowledge, understanding and skills in a wide range of subjects. Our timetable is structured so that students can be accelerated to study subjects at different levels in the same year.

CHOICE OF QUALIFICATIONS

Avondale College offers senior students the choice of studying towards a National Certificate of Educational Achievement (NCEA) in Levels 1, 2 and 3, and Scholarship, or the Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) qualification at IGCSE, AS and A Levels.

CONVALIDATION

Reports and any credits or grades achieved whilst studying in New Zealand are officially provided to the student's home country, to help convalidate the student exchange. Additionally, Avondale College can arrange for an apostille to be prepared to accompany international student reports, or can communicate directly school to school.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE SUPPORT

An interview and placement test on arrival at Avondale College determines the student's academic level and which English language classes are needed to better integrate into the mainstream classes. The core focus of these ESOL classes is reading, writing, speaking and listening. Other subjects in this programme introduce the New Zealand curriculum of mathematics, science and technology.

MICROSOFT AND CISCO IT NETWORKING ACADEMIES

Avondale College is unique in offering two prestigious globally-recognised Academy courses in information and communication technology.

Avondale College is working in partnership with Microsoft to provide an innovative ICT programme in which students have the opportunity to gain additional educational and industrial certifications as well as demonstrate proven, market-ready ICT experience to future employers based on completing real world projects with practical application.

The CISCO Networking Academy prepares students for industry-recognised certification and entry-level ICT careers in virtually every type of industry. In this course, students develop foundational skills in ICT while acquiring vital 21st-century career skills in problem solving, collaboration and critical thinking.

SCHOLARS' ACADEMY

The Avondale College Scholars' Academy is designed to extend and enrich members, academically, both individually and collectively, in an Academy environment. It also aims at fostering participation and success in the NZQA Scholarship examination through workshops and tutorials.

PERFORMING ARTS ACADEMY

The Avondale College Performing Arts Academy offers our most gifted and passionate young artists the opportunity to develop their talents in a rich environment resourced with specialist teachers and purpose-built facilities. The four academy strands offered to students in Year 9 and Year 10 are: Drama, Dance, Music (Jazz) and Music (Classical).

SPORTS ACADEMY

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ACTIVITY PROGRAMME

TRIPS AND TOURS

Each semester the International Department organises at least one weekend trip to popular New Zealand destinations, such as Rotorua, Bay of Islands, Wellington and the Coromandel Peninsula, enabling students to experience some of the unique features for which New Zealand is famous.

During the school holidays there are opportunities to travel on supervised trips to the North and South Islands of New Zealand and even to Australia or Fiji. In winter students also may participate in ski weekends organised by trusted providers.

CAMP

At Avondale College we are very fortunate to have our own camping facility, 'Taurewa', located on the volcanic plateau in the central North Island. While at camp students have the opportunity to particpate in many fun activities, including white water rafting, caving, hiking, mountain biking and skiing (in winter). Students may choose to go with their form class, or with other international students.

SPORTS EXCHANGE

Avondale College's international students enjoy twiceyearly sporting exchanges, competing for highly-coveted trophies in basketball and football.

SUMMER PROGRAMME

This includes fun activities that are based in and out of school. Special classes such as Psychology, Photography, New Zealand History, Technology, Food Technology and Maori traditions are held at school. Outdoor activities include a full day sailing course, hiking on Rangitoto Island in Auckland's harbour, mountain biking, indoor snow skiing, zip-lining on Waiheke Island and wind surfing. The camp is also included in this programme and is a fun way to end the year.




ORIENTATION

A thorough orientation programme helps all international students to settle into Avondale College life and their new environment. Individual and group meetings are held to make sure students understand the student handbook and guidelines for accommodation.

STUDENT SUPPORT

Avondale College provides for the educational and welfare needs of each student by providing support structures at both academic deans' level and from the International Student Centre. Staff give encouragement and support in all areas of school life and students can be confident that help is readily available. The International Student Committee provide a student 'buddy system' for new international students, to help in the settling in phase. Their activities include organising events for international students.





HOMESTAY

Our homestay service enables students to become part of a caring New Zealand family. Avondale College places much importance on finding the right place to live for the students. Staying with friendly and welcoming families is compulsory for any international student and from our experience, is the best option.

From Monday to Friday, students will eat breakfast and dinner with the host family – lunch will be provided for the student to eat at school. On the weekend all meals are

provided by the host family. All students have their own room and every effort is made to match the student with a compatible family.

Homestay arrangements are organised and monitored directly by International Student Centre staff. Host families are carefully selected and must sign a contract that details specific rules and standards.



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
