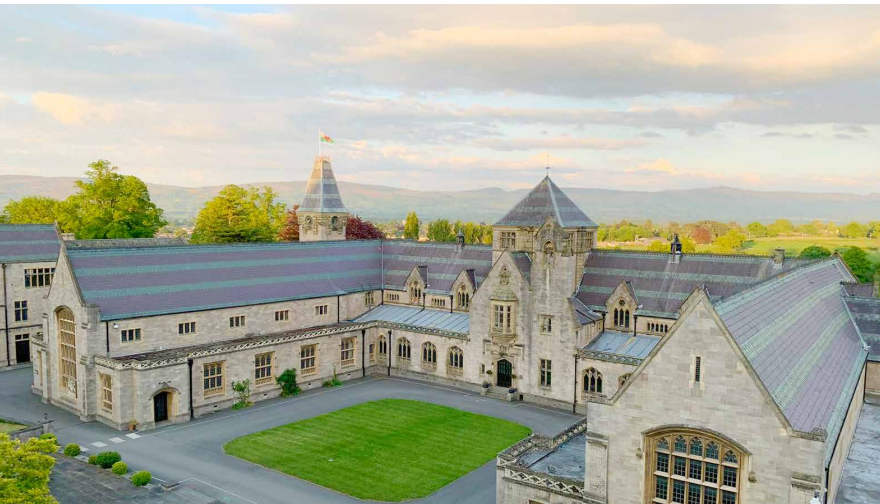

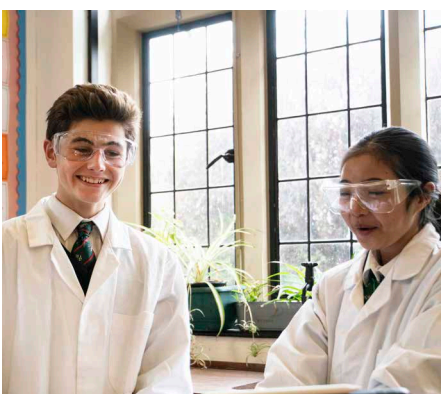

BOARDING AT MYDDELTON

Boarders at Myddelton College are part of a large family community; they encourage a sense of belonging and a feeling of personal fulfilment in a happy, stable, caring and friendly environment. Whilst academic progression is a high priority, Myddelton College want students to participate fully in the wide range of sporting, cultural and leisure activities on offer also. There are two boarding houses at Myddelton College. They have St. George's House and Stanley's House. St. George's is the Junior boarding house and is for students aged 11 – 16. Stanley's House is the senior boarding house and is for students aged 15-18. Each boarding house has a residential houseparent, who is supported by an assistant residential houseparent and a matron. Myddelton offer an extensive range of trips & activities which take place each weekend and throughout half term breaks. They encourage students to experience the various opportunities and enjoy the beauty of the different places they visit. The programme of trips on offer includes visits to cities such as Liverpool and Manchester. There are regular outings to the cinema, ice skating, places like the Trafford Centre to do a bit of shopping. They also offer more active excursions that allow students to explore the rural areas of Wales such as Zip World, Bounce Below and Zip Forest!

ELITE SPORTS

Myddelton College run a Tennis Academy in collaboration with Tennis Wales. Students can benefit from first rate coaching, take part in local and national competitions and even take a trip to the home of British tennis - Wimbledon! Students are also able to work towards and earn the Lawn Tennis Association Coaching badges.

The new, APD partnered Football Academy at Myddelton College offers students an excellent opportunity to develop their skills both on and off the pitch. APD have supported over 50 players in gaining professional and semi-professional playing contracts at English clubs. Students within the Football Academy can benefit from several group training sessions each week as well as an individual coaching session. They can also play in weekly matches, follow a structured fitness and conditioning plan and work towards FA Coaching badges.

Myddelton College also run an Elite Triathlon programme, utilising coaches with over 40 years of combined professional experience. The programme is suitable for triathletes, swimmers, cyclists and track and field athletes. Students benefit from individualised training programmes.

OUTSTANDING STUDENT SUPPORT
