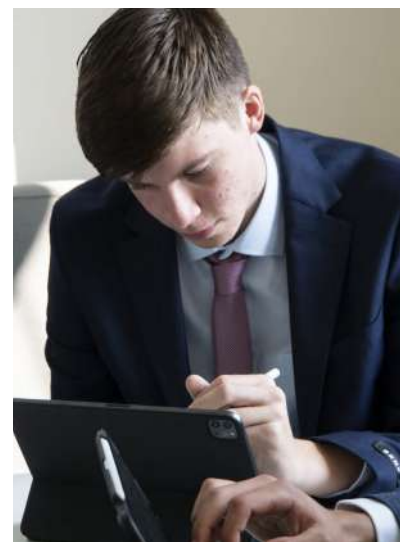
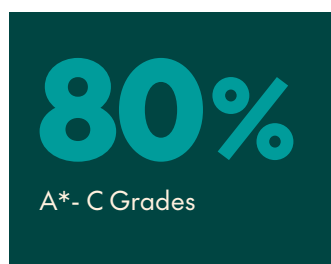

Campus Facilities

The college is located at the foot of the 13th-century Denbigh Castle, combining **historic architecture with modern learning facilities**. Academic buildings support science, technology and classroom-based learning, while sports facilities support training across multiple disciplines. The surrounding countryside provides additional space for outdoor activity and recreation, contributing to a focused boarding environment.

Residential life

Myddelton College offers a full boarding experience where students live and study on campus. Boarding accommodation provides **shared rooms, common areas and supervised study spaces**. Boarding staff support students' daily routines, wellbeing and academic progress, creating a structured environment that balances study, sport and personal development. Educatius UK is accredited by the Boarding School Association (BSA).

Athletics and Arts

Myddelton College runs specialist sports programmes including a Tennis Academy in partnership with Tennis Wales, an APD partnered Football Academy and an Elite Triathlon programme. Training is led by experienced coaches and supported by on-site and local facilities.

Arts provision includes music technology, drama and creative clubs that complement academic studies. Students can explore creative interests alongside their core curriculum.
