SPORTS AND ARTS

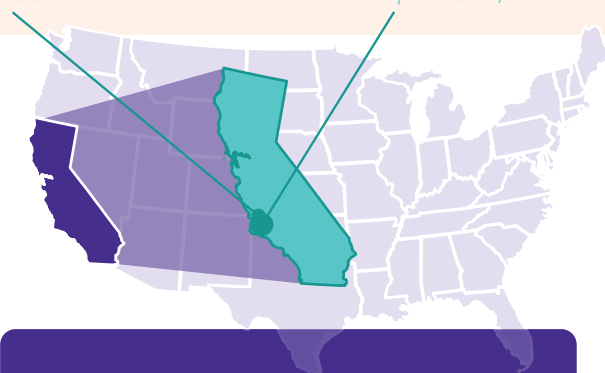
