AWARDS AND ACCOMPLISHMENTS

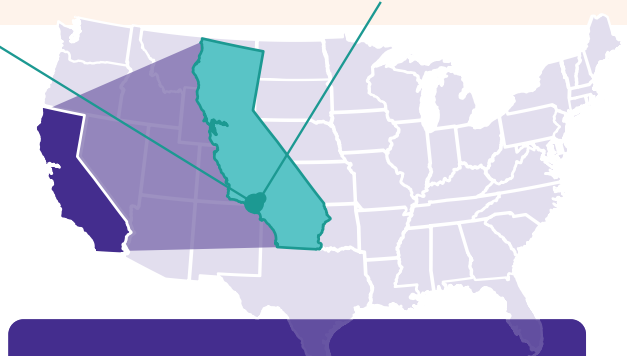
