



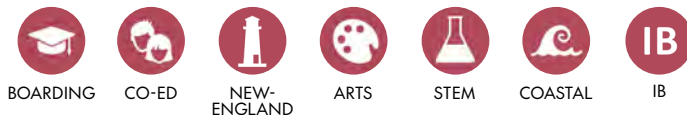

Campus Facilities

The St. Andrew's campus spans approximately 80 acres in a suburban coastal Rhode Island community. Academic facilities support a broad curriculum including science, mathematics, languages, and the arts. Athletic amenities include two gymnasiums, a fitness center, tennis courts, squash courts, and multiple fields. Arts programming is housed in dedicated spaces with support for visual, music, dance, and dramatic arts. Outdoor areas provide access to natural environments and proximity to Narragansett Bay recreational opportunities.

Residential Life

Boarding is available for students in upper grades and postgraduate. Residential houses provide shared rooms and common living spaces under adult supervision. Dining facilities serve all students and promote community engagement. Boarding students represent a mix of domestic and international origins, participating fully in school life including afternoon activities and weekend programs.

Athletics and Arts

St. Andrew's integrates athletics into daily student life, requiring participation in team sports or fitness activities from ninth grade. Teams compete in the South East New England (SENE) Athletic Conference.

The arts program offers visual art, music, dance, and dramatic arts throughout middle and upper school, including annual performances and exhibitions.

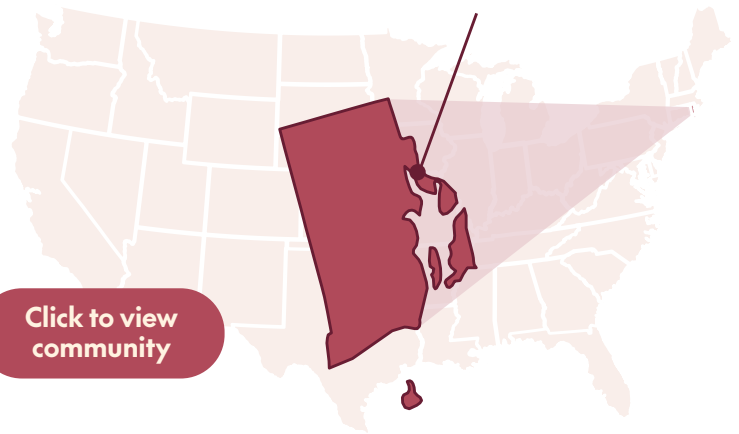
