Campus Facilities

Menaul School is set on a 32-acre campus in Albuquerque, providing a calm, college-like environment within the city. Facilities include academic classrooms, science labs, art studios, music and performance spaces, and multiple athletic fields. Students have access to gymnasiums and outdoor sports areas that support year-round training. The compact campus layout encourages close interaction between students and faculty while offering space for both academic focus and extracurricular activities.

Residential Life

Boarding students live on campus in supervised residential housing designed to support academic focus and independence. Residences offer shared rooms, common lounges, and structured routines that balance study time and social life. Dining services provide daily meals on campus, and residential staff support students' wellbeing and adjustment. Boarding students come from diverse regional and international backgrounds, creating a multicultural residential community.

Athletics and Arts

Athletics at Menaul School emphasize participation, skill development, and teamwork. Students can join sports teams regardless of prior experience, with opportunities available across multiple seasons. The school also partners with external organizations to offer advanced training opportunities, including a professional soccer academy pathway for dedicated athletes.

The arts program provides students with broad exposure to visual and performing arts while building creative discipline and technical skills. Courses are taught by practicing artists and focus on both creative expression and performance. Students can explore multiple artistic fields alongside their academic studies.

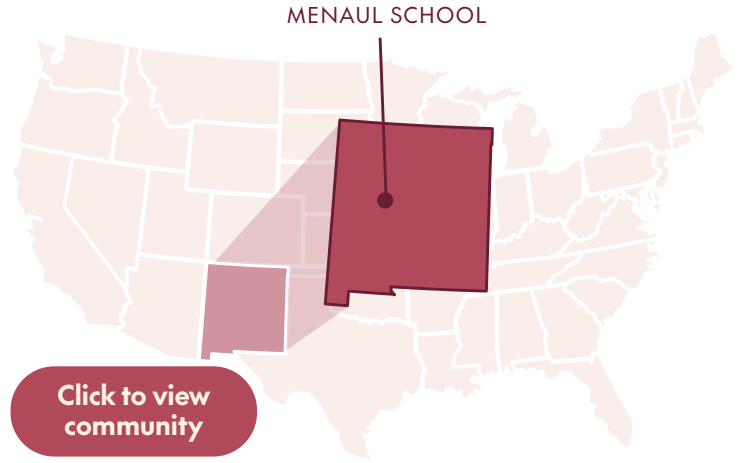
