Campus Facilities

The 34-acre campus features modern academic buildings that support upper and lower school programs. Facilities include **science laboratories, music rooms, gymnasiums, and a 2,000-seat stadium** used for athletic competitions and school events. Dedicated spaces support arts instruction and extracurricular activities, allowing students to balance academics, athletics, and creative pursuits within a single campus environment.

Athletics and Arts

Athletics play a major role in student life at Ezell-Harding, with teams competing under the Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association. The school has earned 24 state championships across multiple sports, reflecting a strong culture of discipline, teamwork, and competitive excellence.

The arts program supports student creativity through visual and performing arts opportunities. Students participate in theater productions, band, and choral ensembles, developing performance skills and artistic expression alongside academic study.

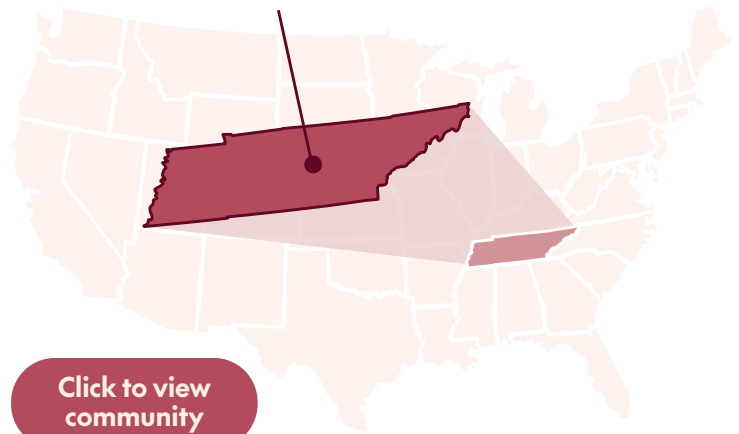
