Campus Facilities

The Coventry High School campus was significantly modernized in 2001 and now features **a state-of-the-art science wing, updated computer labs, a media center, and an expanded gymnasium**. The school includes a large auditorium used for performances and community events, along with two outdoor courtyards that provide quiet study and social spaces. Additional art studios and an auxiliary gym support a wide range of extracurricular and athletic activities. These facilities offer students access to **modern resources** that enhance both academic learning and creative exploration.

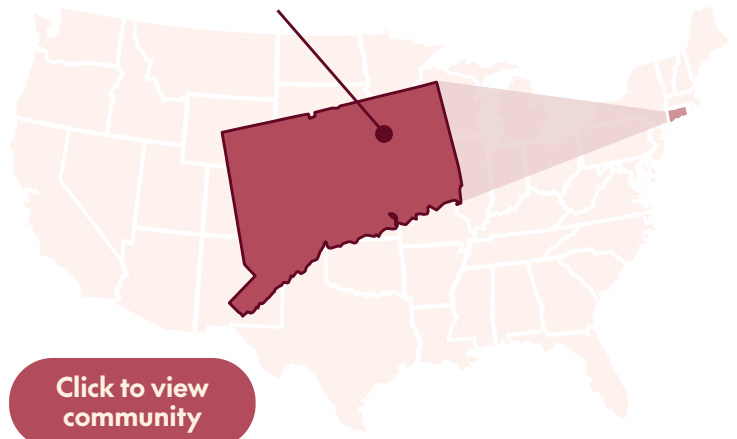
